

Cork Placemats & Coasters



Cork is a wonderfully versatile material - and it's fast rate of growth means it's a particularly sustainable crop, but to achieve it's maximum product life, it must be carefully cared for. Here's a few tips to help you extend that longevity.

- Not suitable for your dishwasher.
- Do not immerse in water.
- Not suitable for use as a cutting board
- May stain from foods with strong colours.

To clean:

Use a sponge or cloth and a solution of basic soapy water to gently scrub the cork. Cork should be cleaned lightly and infrequently (unless needed!).

To dry:

Mold and mildew love wet cork. To avoid moldy cork, make sure you remove all the water from this porous material after cleaning it. Use a cloth and press on the cork to dry it. Once you've pressed out as much water as you can, leave the cork to air dry completely. Do not store the cork until it is completely dry.
